WEBB LODGE HISTORY

On August 24th, 1892, Webbs Lodge, through its Worshipful Master, entered a very important contract with Mrs. Mary A. Walker, who before her death became Mrs. Mary A. Mason. In the contract she agreed to include in her last will and testament a

bequest to Webbs Lodge #166 of five thousand dollars, \$5,000, on condition that they keep in good condition in perpetuity her two sections in what was then known as the City Cemetery, but now is known as Magnolia Cemetery. The bequest was made and at her death was paid to the Lodge and is the fund for which three Trustees are annually elected by the Lodge to handle the fund and see that the conditions of the contract are faithfully performed.
